

Franco Bassanini, former Italian Cabinet Minister for Public Administration and Regional Affairs (1996-2001) and Professor of Constitutional Law at the First University of Rome, is now Chairman of Cassa Depositi e Prestiti (the most important Italian long term investor in infrastructures, energy, and public utilities) and President of Astrid, a think tank gathering together about 300 scientists in the field of European and national institutions, public policies, public administration, market regulation and e-government (www.astrid.eu). He is also member of the french *Commission pour la Libération de la Croissance française* (Attali Committee) and *Commission pour la coopération euroméditerranéenne* (Milhaud Committee) .
